Lecture Information

A 50 Year Retrospective - My Failures and Lessons Learned

J. William Robbins, DDS, MA

It has been said that “success is a poor teacher.” In this presentation, Dr. Robbins will show failures of his cases and lessons he has learned in the past 50 years. He will discuss several areas with possible solutions to the failures he experienced. Dr. Robbins has created an educational experience in six subjects to assist you in your practice.

- Understand and describe the many clinical and behavioral failures the speaker has experienced during his 50 years of clinical practice.
- Evaluate and describe lessons the speaker has learned in dealing with these failures.

Can We Really Make Better Dentures?

Lyndon F. Cooper, D.D.S., Ph.D., F.A.C.P

Despite forecasts that we will no longer be making dentures, dentures continue to be demanded in clinical practice.

Unfortunately, many dentures are required for individuals from lower socioeconomic segments of the population. New clinical concepts are required. We need to make excellent dentures more reproducibly, faster and simpler. This presentation will introduce a clinical method for denture construction that uses intraoral landmarks to define esthetic and functional guidelines in denture construction. The approach is agnostic with regard to analog (wax) or digital construction (printed/milled) of the denture.

We will explore how an integrated anatomic approach to design of dentures positively impacts the entire process of denture therapy, patient experience, and measured outcomes of denture therapy.

Objectives:

At the conclusion of this lecture, participants will be able to:

1. Identify comprehensive and some novel anatomic determinants of midline, occlusal plane and vertical dimension of occlusion.
2. Understand and explain what is important in clinical denture procedures and how a methodology can simplify the traditionally complex and error prone steps in denture construction.
3. Understand and appreciate how moving to digital denture design and manufacture can accelerate and improve denture therapy for clinicians, patients, and populations.

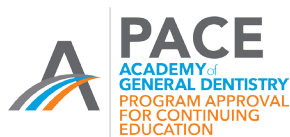

Speakers' Bios:

J. William Robbins, D.D.S., M.A., maintains a full-time private practice and is Clinical Professor in the Department of Comprehensive Dentistry at the University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio Dental School. He graduated from the University of Tennessee Dental School in 1973. He completed a rotating internship at the Veterans Administration Hospital in Leavenworth, Kansas and a 2-year General Practice Residency at the V. A. Hospital in San Diego, California.



Dr. Robbins has published over 80 articles, abstracts, and chapters on a wide range of dental subjects and has lectured in the United States, Canada, Mexico, South America, Europe, Middle East, China, and Africa. He coauthored a textbook, *Fundamentals of Operative Dentistry – A Contemporary Approach*, which is published by Quintessence, and is in its 4th edition. He recently co-authored a new textbook, *Global Diagnosis – A New Vision of Dental Diagnosis and Treatment Planning*, which is also published by Quintessence.

He has won several awards including the Presidential Teaching Award at the University of Texas Health Science Center, the 2002 Texas Dentist of the Year Award, the 2003 Honorary Thaddeus V. Weclaw Fellowship Award from the Academy of General Dentistry, the 2010 Saul Schluger Award given by the Seattle Study Club, the Southwest Academy of Restorative Dentistry 2015 President's Award, and the 2016 Academy of Operative Dentistry Award of Excellence.

Dr. Robbins is a diplomate of the American Board of General Dentistry. He is past president of the American Board of General Dentistry, the Academy of Operative Dentistry, the Southwest Academy of Restorative Dentistry, and the American Academy of Restorative Dentistry.

Dr. Lyndon Cooper is the Dean of the Virginia Commonwealth University's School of Dentistry. He was formerly the Associate Dean for Research and Head of the Department of Oral Biology at University of Illinois School of Dentistry, Chicago and served as Stallings Distinguished Professor of Dentistry, Chairperson and Director of Graduate Prosthodontics at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. Dr. Cooper is a Diplomate of the American Board of Prosthodontics and served as the 2010 President of the American College of Prosthodontists and later the Chair of the American College of Prosthodontists Education Foundation. He received the ACP's 2004 Clinician/Researcher Award, the IADR's 2009 Distinguished Scientist Award for Prosthodontics and Implantology, the IADR/AO Osseointegration Innovation in Implant Sciences Award, and the 2016 Greater New York Academy of Prosthodontists' Schweitzer Award for Research and most recently the 2022 ACEF Founder's Award. Dr. Cooper remains active in research, teaching and patient care and is focused on enhancing dental education, providing for dental therapeutic excellence, and improving access to oral health care.
