

Successful dental practices are run with a few key mantras in mind— clinical patient experience, clinical outcome and practice profitability. Digital implant surgical and restorative dentistry, as well as full-arch fixed implant therapy (All on X), are no different. Implant tooth-replacement therapy is an ever-growing treatment choice for our dental populations. The dental practitioner of today must be familiar with the parts, processes and critical steps involved. Thankfully, the digital implant workflows that we are afforded today as dentists are unlike any we have seen before.

Utilizing 3D CBCT imaging, intraoral scanning, fully guided and timed surgery, as well as virtual scan body technology, the doctor, team and patient of today, are afforded a multitude of digital implant workflows— from straightforward single-unit cases to esthetic anterior immediate placement and fixed provisionalizations. But also, using the same concepts, translated into guided crestal sinus augmentation and digital All on X therapy.

This novel approach to pre-surgical preparation affords the practitioner a consistent, repeatable digital workflow for successful full arch fixed implant therapy. Prior to surgery, a digital prosthetic plan is formulated, surgical guide(s) and immediate prostheses are virtually formulated and can be 3D
